

Watch for your packet in the mail!

You will get an enrollment packet in the mail. *Open it, Read it, Respond to it!* You will have at least 30 days to choose the best plan for you or your family.

If you do not make a choice, a health plan will be chosen for you.

90 days to change your plan

Once you enroll, you have 90 days to change your health plan one time. After this 90-day period ends, you stay in your health plan for the rest of the year unless you have a special reason to make a change.

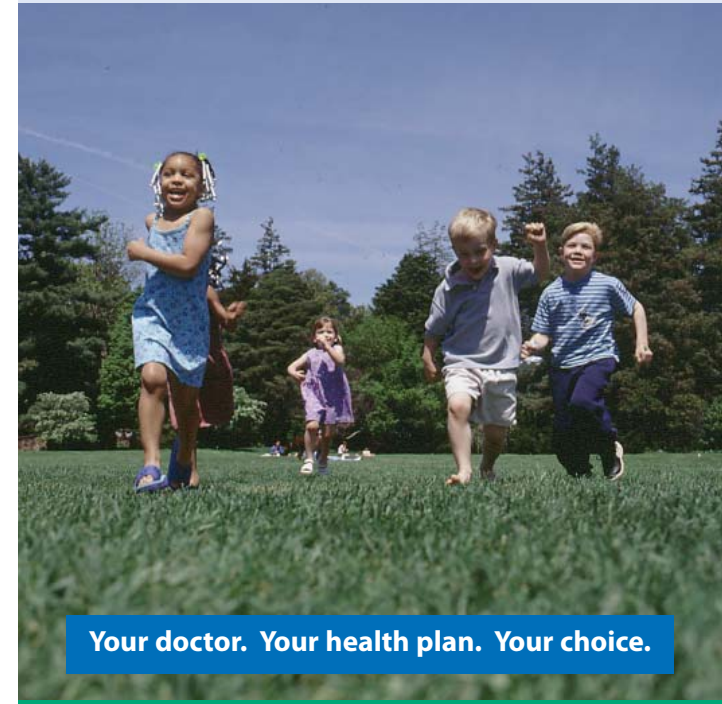

What is South Carolina Healthy Connections Choices?

South Carolina Healthy Connections Choices is a program that helps Medicaid members enroll in health plans. When members enroll, they choose a health plan and a doctor (or clinic). Healthy Connections Choices will help members choose a health plan that is best for them.

What is a health plan?

A health plan is a group of doctors (or clinics) and may also include hospitals and other staff. Your health plan will make sure you can see the right doctor when you need to. All plans provide the same medical services as Medicaid. The plans may also offer extra services, such as diabetes or asthma management programs.

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Your health plan benefits

As a member of a health plan you can get many health services, such as:

- Regular checkups
- Prenatal care
- Prescription drugs

Also, most health plans have an advice phone line. When you call, a nurse can answer your health questions.

Choosing the health plan that is best for you

All health plans offer at least the same medical services as Fee-for-Service Medicaid. Some health plans also offer extra services.

Ask your doctor about the health plans, so you can choose a health plan your doctor works with. That way, you can keep seeing the doctor you see now. If you don't choose a health plan you may need to change your doctor.

How do you enroll?

Enrolling is fast and easy!

Four ways to enroll

1. **Phone:** To enroll by phone, call 1-877-552-4642.
2. **Mail or fax:** To enroll by mail, watch for your packet in the mail. *Open it, Read it, Respond to it!*
3. **Internet:** Enroll on our website, www.SCchoices.com. Choose *Log in* on the left menu.
4. **In person:** Go to a community meeting, where a trained enrollment counselor can help you enroll. Some enrollment counselors speak Spanish. To find a community meeting, call 1-877-552-4642, or visit www.SCchoices.com.

What you'll need to tell us:

- Your full name
- Medicaid ID number
- Date of birth
- Address and telephone number
- Your doctor (or clinic) if you have chosen one
- Doctor's address

Newborn babies will be added to the mother's health plan. The mother has 90 days from the date of the baby's birth to change the baby's health plan.
